# Programme

## *Musical Director: Peter Cammell*

Peter studied music at Auckland and Otago Universities and taught in both Auckland and London. He has played the violin and the recorder, but his main interest has always been in choral singing and conducting.

He has sung in the Dorian choir, Auckland Anglican Cathedral choir, Cantus Firmus and Musica Sacra, and is currently with both Calico Jam and The Graduate Choir.

Peter has now been director of Kowhai Singers for over 15 years and he has worked at extending the choir's repertoire. Audiences have come to expect a mixture of styles, and, like the choir, have often been challenged by the unfamiliar, fulfilling one of Peter's declared aims, to extend the musical understanding of both the audience and the choir.

A conductor with an acute ear, he has a constant passion for pitch, and for improving the vocal quality of the singers, most of whom have untrained voices. The community's support of the now well-established Kowhai Singers is strong, as quietly growing audience numbers testify.

### *Soloist: Nicola Cammell*

Nicola was born in New Zealand and moved to Australia to train at the National Institute of Dramatic Art (NIDA). She spent the first four months of 2010 in Japan where she was the lead vocalist at the New Akao Resort.

Prior to NIDA she trained privately in Auckland and London and appeared as understudy to Peron's Mistress in the New Zealand tour of *Evita*. Other theatre credits include Johanna in *Sweeney Todd*, Emma in *Jekyll and Hyde* and Sharon in *A Slice of Saturday Night*. She also appeared in the Australian children's musical *Showtime* at the Ensemble Theatre, Sydney.

Nicola has made guest appearances in a number of cabaret productions and is currently writing her own one-woman show. She is also a co/creator and principal cast member of the acclaimed cabaret series *Flaw Play* which will play its third season in Sydney in October.
